WEATHER TRENDS

Warm and windy spring, cool September and October. Only one notable heat spike on June 16 (105° F). Mild temperatures the remaining growing season opened the window for picking at optimal maturity.

OVERALL NOTES

2021 was an extremely cool vintage overall. The weather was wet and cool until about July 4 when the temperatures finally reached the mid 70s. This was a late harvest, with concentrated flavors and aromas and high acids. In general, the crop yields are average to above average. This vintage produced crisp white wines with great structure and acidity. The reds are overall elegant and restrained and should be long-lived.
