WEATHER TRENDS

Warmer temperatures overall; cool spring followed by a warmer May. We experienced a couple of heat spikes on August 14–21 (98–99 $^{\circ}$ F) and September 5–7 (90–107 $^{\circ}$ F).

OVERALL NOTES

We experienced a cool spring and summer and projected an average size crop. It was an earlier harvest than previous years. Although we had a couple of minor heat spells and a small amount of smoke during the early stage of harvest from the Northern California fires, we made beautiful wines in 2020. They show good concentration of flavor, lush full body, and generous tannins across the board.
